Flash memory is the type of non-volatile memory that can be electronically erased and reprogrammed. Its name was invented by Toshiba to express how much faster it could be erased' in a flash' which means 'very quickly'. Unlike RAM, which is volatile, flash memory retains the information stored in the chip when the power is turned off. In addition, it offers fast read access times (although not as fast as RAM). Unlike ROM chips, flash memory chips are rewritable, so you can update programs via software.

Flash memory is used in several ways: Many PCs have their BIOS(basic input/output system)stored on a flash memory chip so it can be updated if necessary. Modems use flash memory because it allows the manufacturer to support new protocols. USB flash drives are used to save and move MP3s and other data files between computers. However, USB flash drives have less storage capacity than hard drives. Flash memory cards are used to store images on cameras, to back up data on PDAs, to transfer games in video consoles, to record voice and music on MP4 players. Another option is to have a flash card reader permanently connected to your PC. The future of hard drives may be hybrid hard drives. Hybrid hard drives combine a magnetic hard disk and flash memory into one device.
